With deep regret we inform you of the passing this morning of our dear colleague, Ray Carroll at the age of 59.

Ray was the Director of the MBA program in the School of Business and Professor of Accounting. He began his Dalhousie teaching career, part time, in 1977 after the completion of his MBA. He also taught accounting at the Halifax Regional Vocational School (later NSCC) during that time. He joined Dalhousie full time in 1986 as a visiting professor and later became Associate Professor in 1987. During his career with Dalhousie University Ray obtained his PhD and the rank of Full Professor. He was currently serving as the President of the Dalhousie University Club.

Ray had great enthusiasm for everything he did and was especially passionate about his family, his students and his experience living in China. We will always remember his steadfastness and good humour while facing his health challenges, always putting others before himself. Ray was a driving force in the MBA program and its renewal and that will be just one of the wonderful legacies he will leave here at Dalhousie.
